Matthew 7:17

Matthew 12:32-34

³² Anyone who speaks a word against the **Son of** Man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come. 33 "Make a tree good and its **fruit** will be good, or make a tree bad and its fruit will be bad, for a tree is recognized by its fruit. 34 You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of. (NIV®)



Matthew 13:8, 23

⁸Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown... ²³But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown." (NIV®)



Galatians 5:22-23

²² But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. (NIV®)
