


The King Foretold Numbers 24:17





The Exodus

Numbers 24:17

I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near: a star shall come out of Jacob, and a scepter shall rise out of Israel; it shall crush the forehead of Moab and break down all the sons of Sheth. (ESV)



Star

(a star shall come out of Jacob)



Genesis 15:5

Numbers 24:9

<u>He crouched, he lay down like a lion and</u> <u>like a lioness; who will rouse him up?</u> Blessed are those who bless you, and cursed are those who curse you." (ESV)



Genesis 49:9-10

<u>Judah is a lion's cub</u>; from the prey, my son, you have gone up. <u>He stooped down; he crouched as a lion and</u> <u>as a lioness; who dares rouse him? The scepter shall</u> <u>not depart from Judah</u>, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples. (ESV)

<u>He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who</u> <u>is the devil, or Satan, and bound him for a</u> <u>thousand years. He threw him into the Abyss,</u> and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore until the thousand years were ended. (NIV[®])
