Jesus lived and prayed Psalm 22.

When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots. (NIV®)

Psalm 22:18

They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment. (NIV®)

Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads (NIV®)

Psalm 22:7

All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads. (NIV®)

He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'" (NIV®)

Psalm 22:8

"He trusts in the Lord," they say, "let the Lord rescue him.

Let him deliver him, since he delights in him." (NIV®)

About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"). (NIV®)

Psalm 22:1

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from my cries of anguish? (NIV®)
