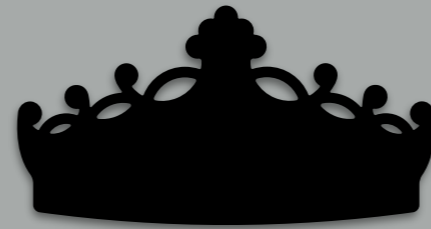

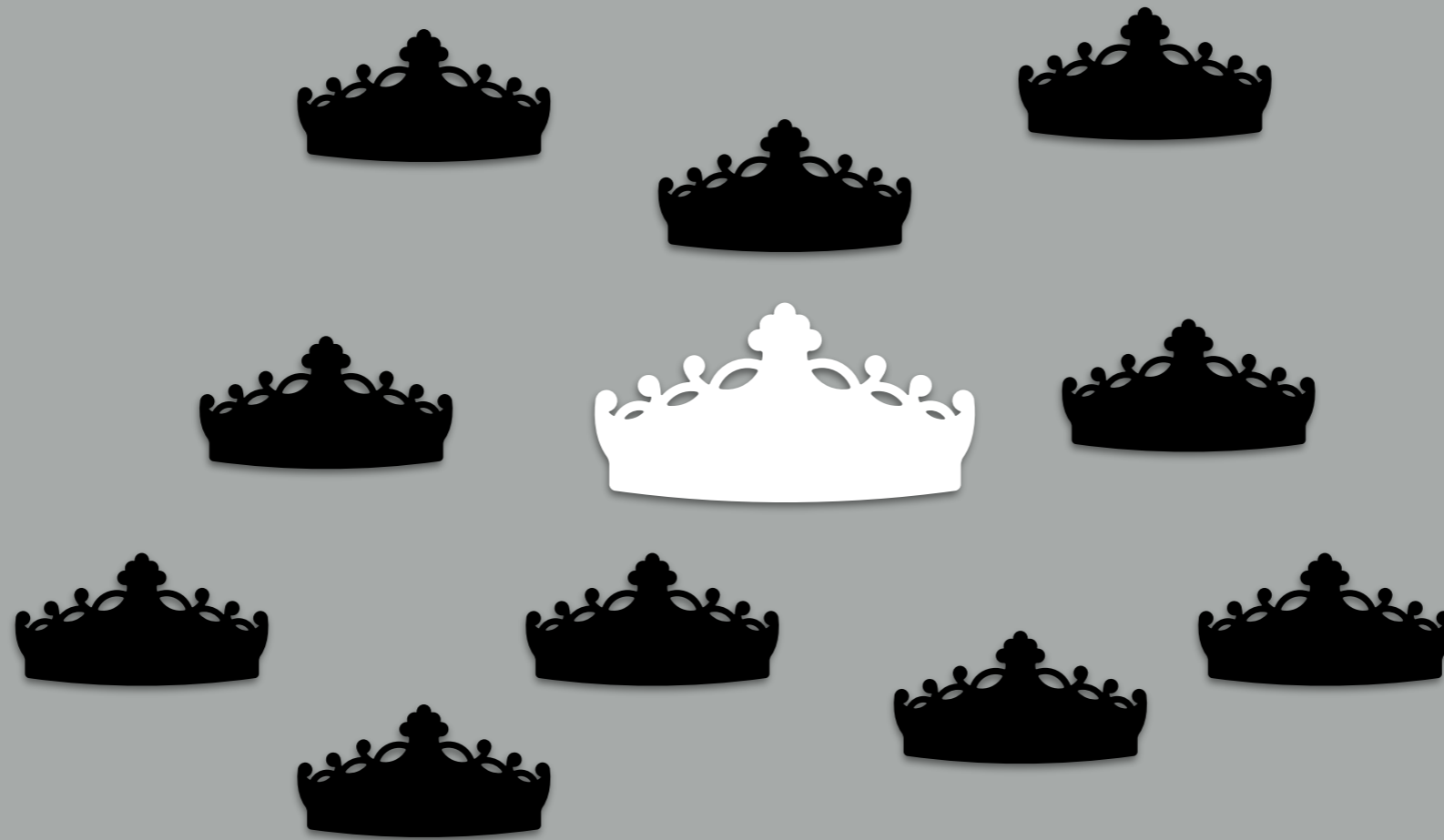


# 2 Samuel 7:16
