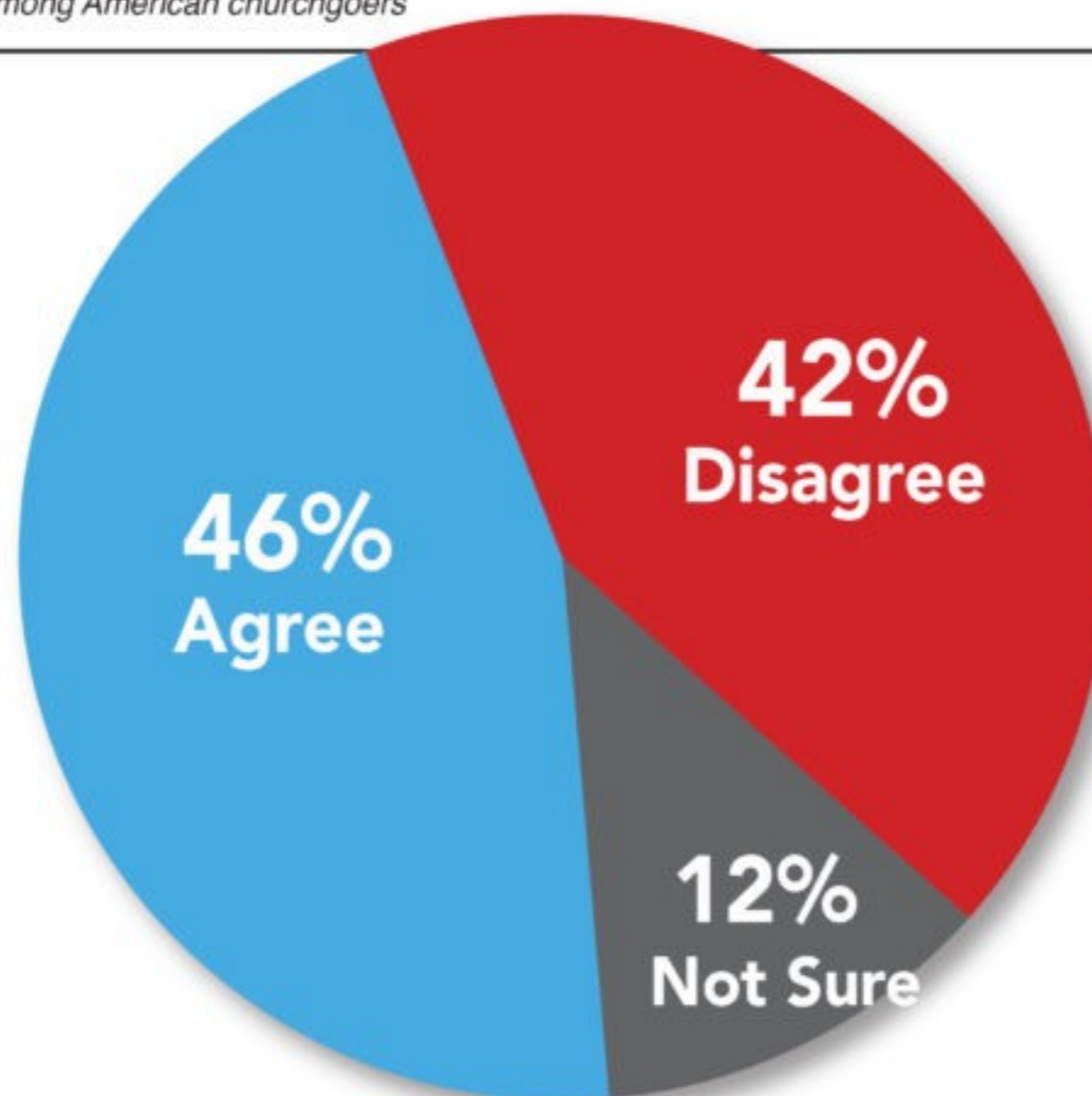
- a. Herodians & Matthew = Pro-government pro-taxes

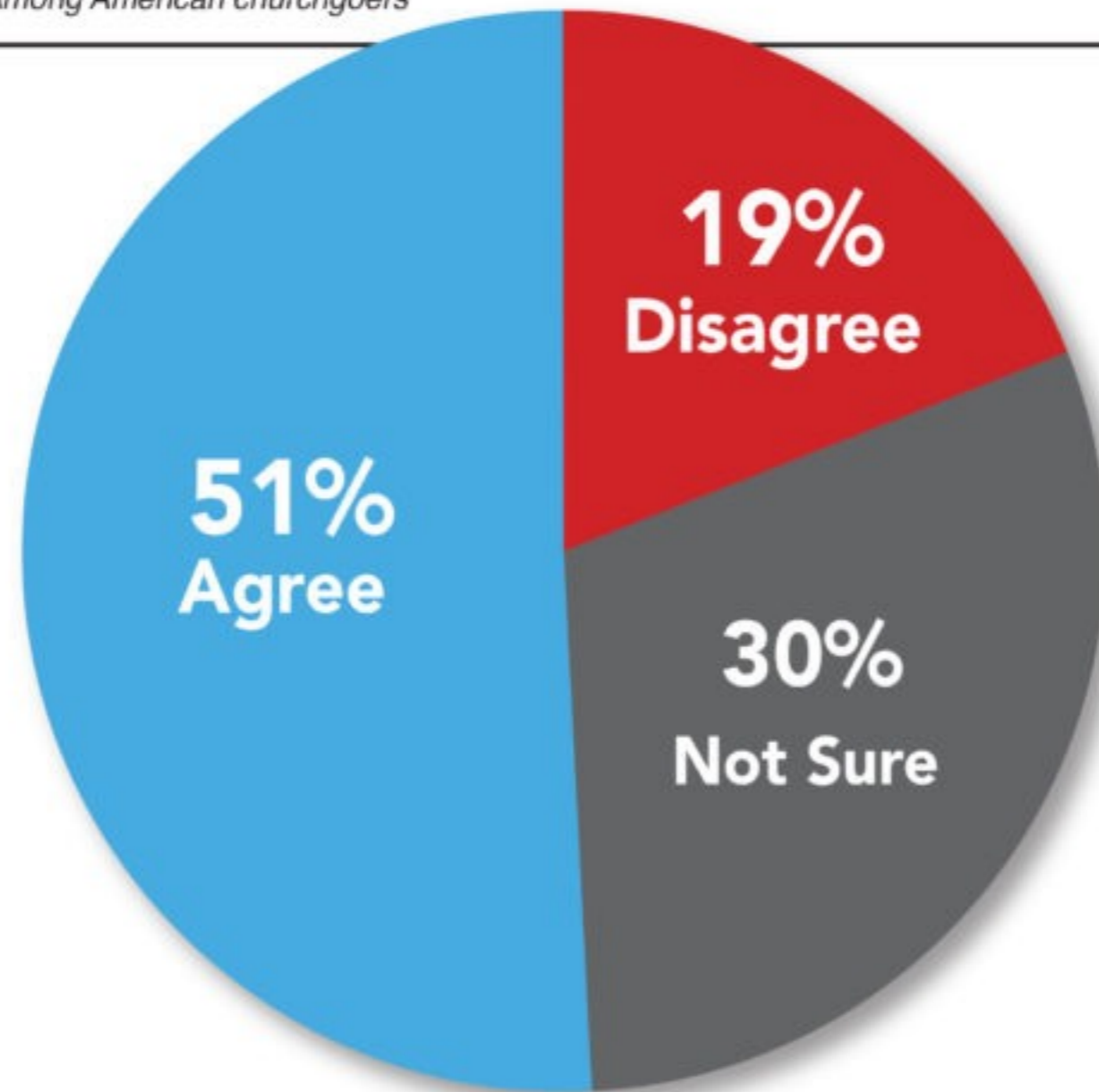

Joshua 5:13-14
