You've come to Jesus wondering who he is.

John 3:1-2

To get into God's kingdom you have to be born again.

John 3:3-4

Fewer people in New England say that they have had a "born again" experience - 16.5% compared to 36.5% for the nation.

John 3:5-7


Ezekiel 36:25-27

To be born again is for the Holy Spirit to come and dwell in you, cleanse you of your sins, and to completely transform you from the inside out through faith in Christ Jesus.

Those who are born again:

- Do what is right (1 John 2:29)
- Turn from their sins and to God (1 John 3:9; 5:18)
- · Love one another (1 John 4:7)
- Overcome the world by faith in Jesus (1 John 5:4-5)
- Believes Jesus is the Messiah God's only chosen Savior. (1 John 5:1)
