

>Unjust Power -Authority that uses others for its own good. (v1-4)


LEVITICUS 19:15

8 Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves,


for the rights of all who are destitute.9 Speak up and judge fairly;defend the rights of the poor and needy. (NIV®)

(v5-8) 18 "Micah of Moresheth prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah. He told all the people of Judah, 'This is what the Lord Almighty says:

"Zion will be plowed like a field, Jerusalem will become a heap of rubble, the temple hill a mound overgrown with thickets.' (NIV®) 19 "Did Hezekiah king of Judah or anyone else in Judah put him to death? <u>Did not Hezekiah</u> <u>fear the Lord and seek his favor? And did not</u> <u>the Lord relent, so that he did not bring the</u> <u>disaster he pronounced against them?</u>..." (NIV®)
