## Covid Update 2/23/2022

- Cornerstone will be following state and town guidelines in regard to COVID-19 mitigation measures.
- We will relax the mask requirement as of February 28th with mask-wearing optional for members and attenders beginning with the March 6th service. We strongly suggest that those who are not vaccinated continue to wear masks. We welcome others to wear masks as they feel the need.
