and praise him in the council of the elders.**

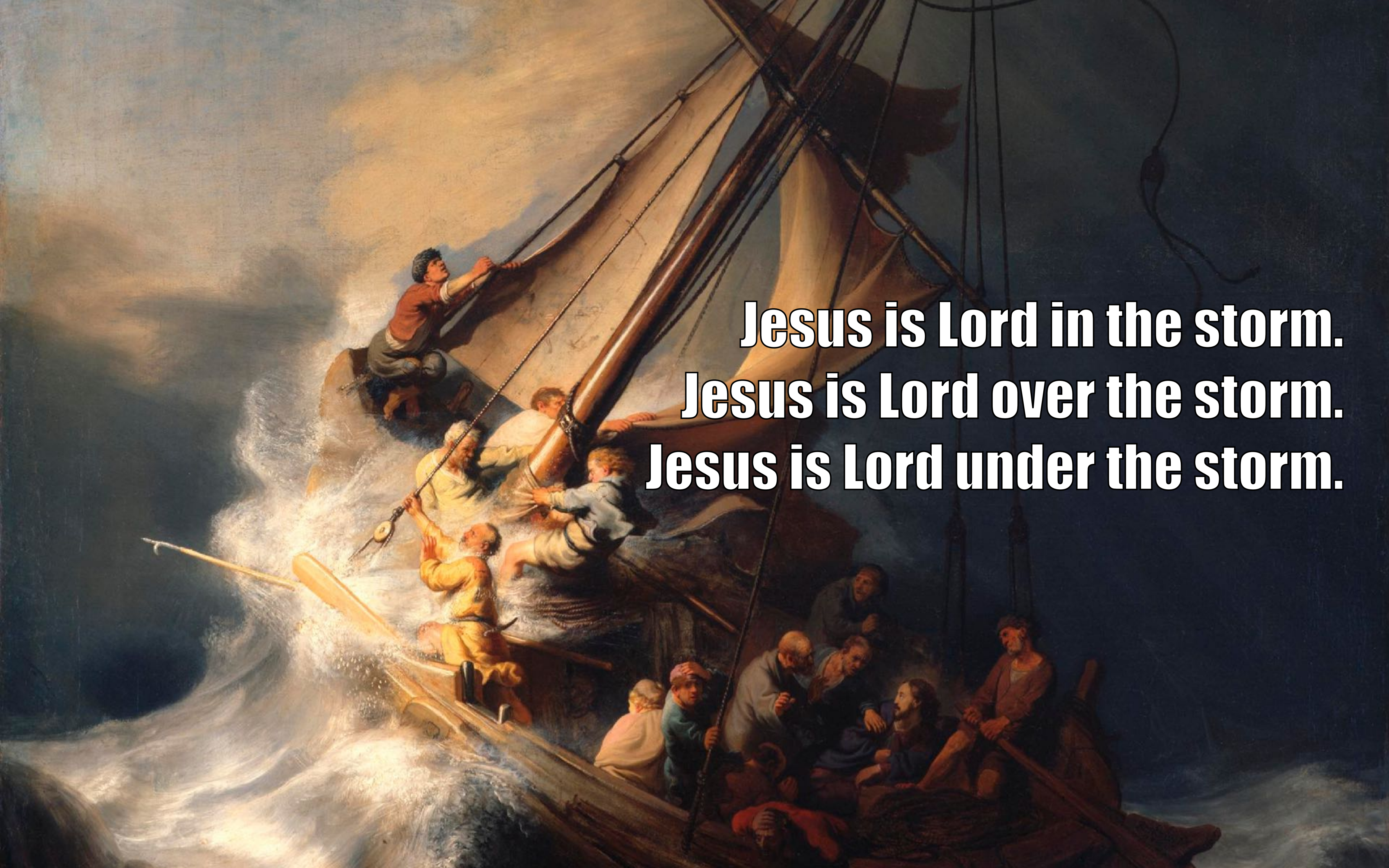
